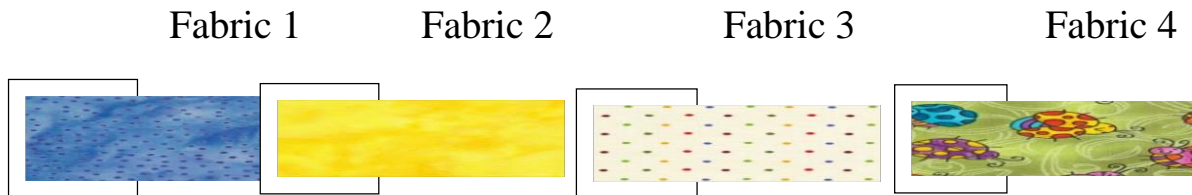


MYSTERY QUILT 2017

Part 1

To avoid confusion label your fabric, I made a sheet of paper with a small corner of the fabric on it and label them 1, 2, 3, 4.



Cutting Instructions: wof means width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge

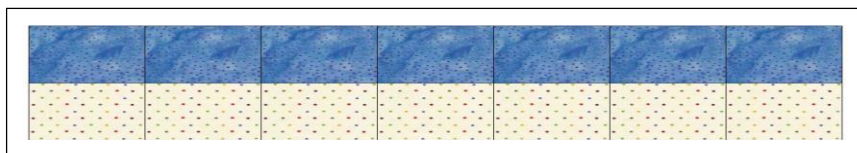
Fabric 1: A 2 strips 2 1/2 " wide X wof
B 2 strips 2 1/2 " x 14"

Fabric 2: E 10 squares 4 1/2"

Fabric 3: F 1 strip 2 1/2" wide X wof
G 1 strip 2 1/2 " wide X 14"
H 10 squares 4 1/2"

Fabric 4: M 1 strip 2 1/2" wide X wof
N 1 strip 2 1/2" wide X 14"
O 10 squares 4 1/2"

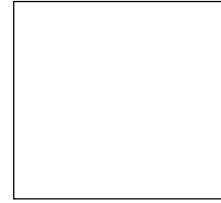
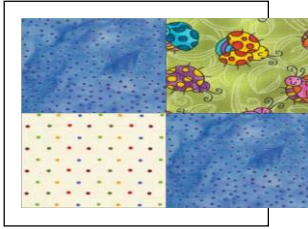
1. Sew an A strip to an F strip and a B strip to a G strip, iron seams toward fabric 1.
2. Cut the resulting strips every 2 1/2" to make 20 pieces. Measurement should be 2 1/2" X 4 1/2".



3. Sew the remaining A strip to the M strip and a B strip to an N strip, iron seams toward fabric 1.

4. Cut the resulting strips every 2 1/2" to make 20 pieces. Measurement should be 2 1/2" X 4 1/2".

5. Make 20 four patches from the 2 1/2" X 4 1/2"



6. Sew an H square to an E square and then add an O square as in Figure 2. Press both seams away from the centre patch.
