

Block 7 – Block of the Month 2021

Twin Star Block

Materials:

4 fabrics or scraps

Cutting of Fabrics:

- A - Cut 1 of fabric 4 – 4 1/2 in square
- Cut 4 of your light/background fabric – 4 1/2 in square



- B - Cut 2 of fabric 3 (large triangle) – 4 7/8 in square



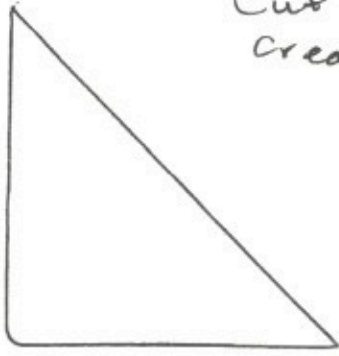
- C - Cut 1 of fabric 1 – 5 1/4 in square
- Cut 1 of fabric 3 – 5 1/4 in square



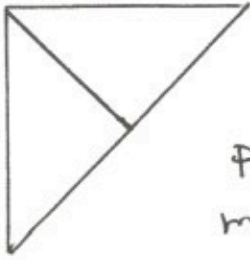
Instructions:

1. Cut 4 A squares and place on felt board or design wall, these are your cornerstones. Cut 1 A in a different fabric for the centre (fabric 4).
2. Cut 2 B squares (4 7/8 in.) and cut in 1/2 to create the 4 triangles. These make the first 1/2 of the B-C unit.
3. After cutting the C squares, cut each 5 1/4 in square into 4 pieces (triangles). Take 1 triangle from fabric 1 and 1 from fabric 3 and sew together to create the C unit. Use a 1/4 in. Seam allowance.
4. After assembling the C unit, sew the C unit and the B triangles together to make the B-C unit.
5. Lay all pieces together on the felt board or design wall following the diagrams provided. Sew the rows together, pressing all seams as you go.

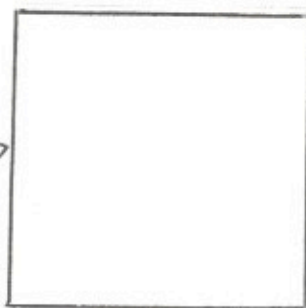
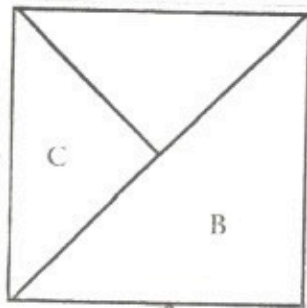
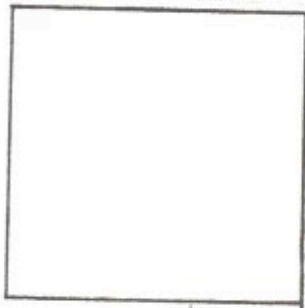
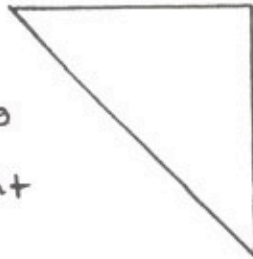
Cut B squares in $\frac{1}{2}$ to
create triangles



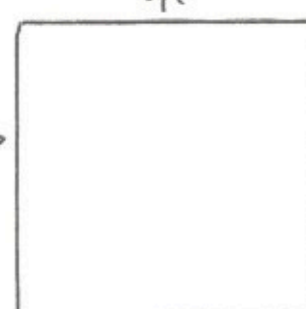
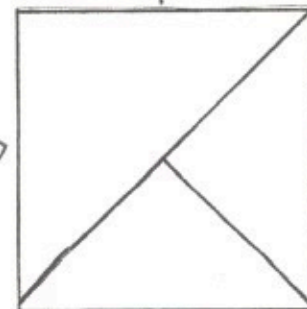
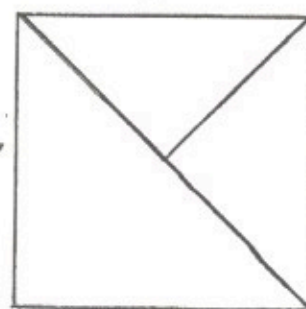
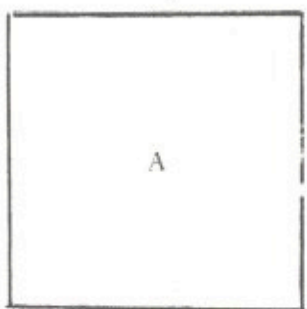
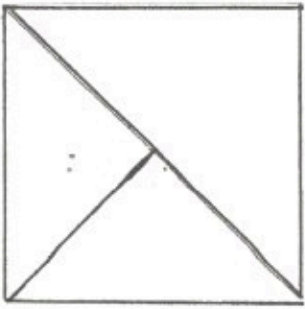
C-unit

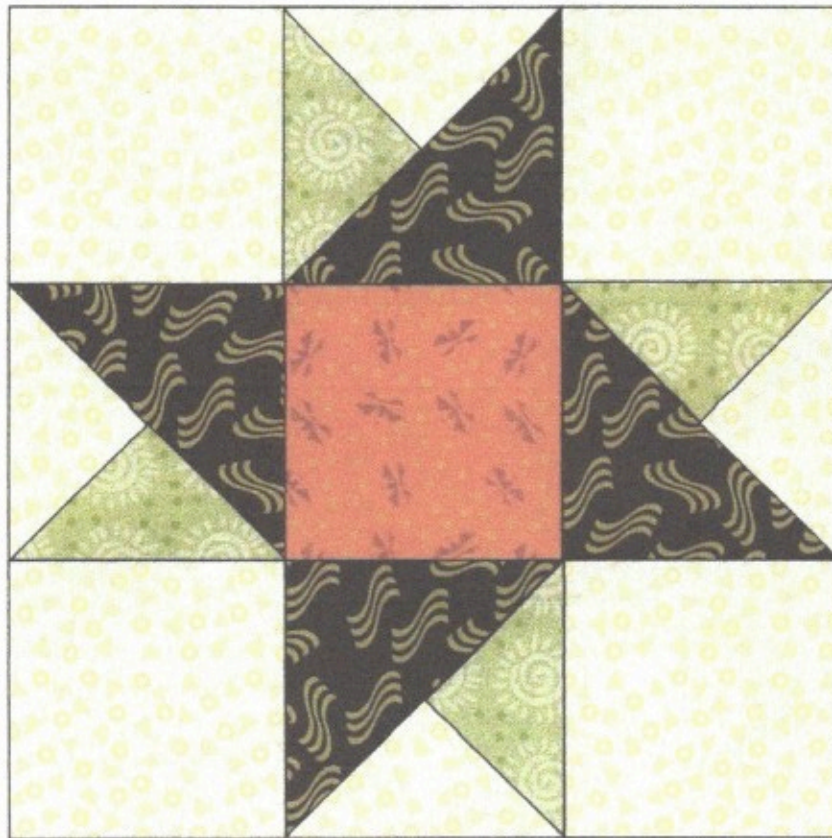


Sew these 2

make the B-C unit

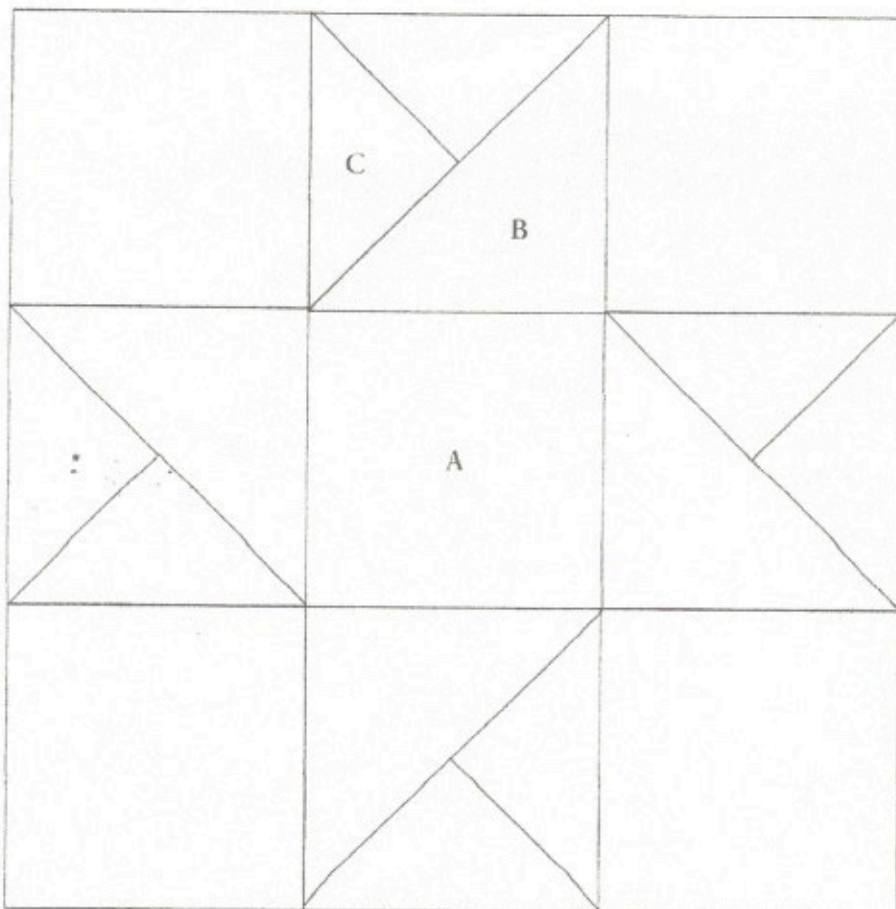


Sew pieces
