
3. Sew the pieces together, you will have 3 rows.



4. Sew the rows together and press the seams as you go. You have made a friendship star.

Note: You could make more of these using a cream, white or other light solid fabric and get people in your quilting group to sign them, or family members for a wedding or family reunion quilt. My husbands family did one of these and then before everyone left to return to their homes, they raffled the quilt off. We had people come from the states and out west. So you get a lovely memory quilt. We sign with out names, date of birth and where we lived.

This could be used as a filler block at the end of the BOM.
