Block of the Month Club - Block 9 - Four Patch Star Block

Cutting:

Light A: Cut 4

3 1/2 in square

Light B: Cut 1

7 1/4 in square

Light C: Cut 2

3 1/2 in square


Medium D: Cut 2

3 1/2 in square

Dark E: Cut 4

3 7/8 in square







Assembly:

- 1. Cut pieces D and C and sew together to create the centre block. This should measure 6 1/2 in square unfinished.
- 2. Cut 4 A background pieces and place on board or design wall. These are your cornerstones.
- 3. Create the 4 flying geese by cutting dark E squares and cut in 1/2. Cut light B square in 4.

Next sew 2 E triangles to both sides of your B triangles. Press as you go and trim to match the measurements of your centre section.

- 4. Sew an assembled flying geese, 1 to the left and 1 to the right, sides of your assembled centre section.
- 5. Next sew a cornerstone A, to both ends of the top and bottom flying geese.
- 6. Sew the rows together to finish assembling your block.
